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#### Qualification and Responsibilities of Interested Parties

To meet the spirit and intent of the State History Code, the SEA will request the views of interested parties, as well as the public, on findings and determinations regarding historic properties for the Lower Hill Redevelopment Project. For this project, in addition to SEA and the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (the State Historic Preservation Officer), interested parties may include representatives of local governments and others who meet the definition of a "consulting party," as defined by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 [36 CFR§800.2 (c) (5)]. The goal of consultation is to identify historic properties potentially affected by the project, assess effects to historic resources, and seek ways to avoid, minimize, or mitigate any adverse effects on historic properties resulting from project implementation.

The SEA will consider whether individuals or organizations meet the test of a demonstrated interest in the project. Those with a demonstrated interest in the undertaking may participate as interested parties due to the nature of their legal or economic relation to the project or affected properties, or their concern with the project's effects on historic properties. Interested parties will be requested to attend all meetings and provide their comments regarding the findings and/or determinations of SEA within an agreed upon time frame. Organizations will be asked to identify one representative to participate on behalf of the group and an alternate.
