

The following is the tentative schedule information for the **I-579 “Cap” Urban Connector Project in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County.**

As always, **all work is weather dependent** and any changes or updates to the schedule will be distributed accordingly.

Continuing Next Week – Monday, April 19th 2021 (weather permitting) (see attached press release)

- **I-579 Southbound nightly Single Lane and Shoulder Closures** will continue between Bedford Ave. and Webster Ave. next **Monday, April 19th through Friday, April 23rd - 8pm to 6am (as needed)**
 - These restrictions are necessary to allow the contractor to complete lighting operations.
- **I-579 nightly short term intermittent Ramp Closures** (Bedford Avenue & 7th Avenue Ramps to Southbound I-579) continue **Monday, April 19th through Friday, April 23rd – 8pm to 6pm (as needed)**
 - These restrictions are necessary to allow the contractor to complete lighting operations.
 - Detour information will be included when the press release is distributed listing specific nights for the ramp closures.

Starting Monday, April 19th through Friday, April 23rd (weather permitting)

- **Washington Place Southbound** between Bigelow Blvd. and Center Ave. AND **Center Avenue Westbound** between Washington Place and Chatham Street will experience **daily single lane closures, as needed, Monday, April 19th through Friday, May 7th – 7am – 5:30pm.**

Continuing - Monday, April 19th through Tuesday June 29th (weather permitting)

- **Chatham Street** between Bigelow Blvd. and Center Ave. will continue to experience **daily closures, as needed, Monday, April 19th through Tuesday, June 29th – 7am – 5:30pm.**
- **Parking on Chatham Street** will continue to **close weekdays**, Monday through Thursdays, **Monday, April 19th through Tuesday, June 29th – 7am – 5:30pm.**

Sidewalk Closure through Tuesday, November 2nd (weather permitting)

- **Center Avenue sidewalk** between Chatham Street and Washington Place **remains closed through Tuesday, November 2, 2021.**
 - The restriction is necessary for the replacement of the sidewalk along Center Avenue. Pedestrians will be detoured to the sidewalk located on the opposite side of the area closed.

Tentative – Monday, April 26th through Friday, April 30th (weather permitting)

- **I-579 Southbound nightly Single Lane and Shoulder Closures** are tentatively scheduled to occur **Monday, April 26th through Friday, April 30th - 8pm to 6am (as needed)**

I-579 nightly short term intermittent Ramp Closures (Bedford Avenue & 7th Avenue Ramps to Southbound I-579) continue **Monday, April 26th through Friday, April 30th – 8pm to 6pm (as needed)**
