

PITTSBURGH, PA (November 24, 2020)

The City of Pittsburgh Department of Mobility and Infrastructure advises that Webster Avenue between Chatham Street and Washington Place will experience full closure from 9AM-3PM on Friday, December 4, 2020. The restriction is necessary to allow the delivery and placement of a utility vault for essential utility work associated with the “CAP Project”. Traffic will be detoured along Bigelow Blvd to Sixth Ave., to Center Ave., and then to Washington Place.

The City of Pittsburgh Department of Mobility and Infrastructure advises that Webster Avenue between Chatham Street and Washington Place will experience nightly lane closures, as needed, from 8PM-6AM starting Tuesday, December 1, 2020 through Friday, January 1, 2021. Traffic will be detoured along Bigelow Blvd to Sixth Ave., to Center Ave., and then to Washington Place. When travelling through the work area, use caution and expect delays.

The City of Pittsburgh Department of Mobility and Infrastructure advises that Chatham Street between Bigelow Blvd. and Center Ave. will experience intermittent closures, daily, as needed, from 7AM-5:30PM, as well as nightly lane closures, as needed, from 8PM-6AM continuing Tuesday, December 1, 2020 through Friday, January 1, 2021. Traffic will be detoured along Bigelow Blvd/Webster Ave. to Washington Place, and then to Centre Avenue. When travelling through the work area, use caution and expect delays.

These restrictions are necessary to allow the contractor to complete essential utility work associated with the “CAP Project”. When travelling through the work area, use caution and expect delays.
