For companies planning to submit their bids between 3:00 pm - 5:00 pm on December 16th, please enter the building through the security check located in the West Lobby, and please proceed to the third-floor, where bids will be accepted in Meeting Room 330 until 5:00 pm.

The bid opening will take place immediately after 5:00 pm.

Is it correct to assume that the prime contractors as discussed during the pre-bid meeting would be solely required to meet the MBE/WBE specifications set forth in the bid documents? Would suppliers and subs to the primes be required to meet requirement also?

Please refer to Section 8 MBE/WBE Program, as stated in the program, the Authority requires that all contractors and subcontractors shall demonstrate a good faith effort to obtain the participation of Minority and Women Business Enterprises in work to be performed for the Authority. It is the goal of the Authority that twenty-five percent (25%) of the contract amount be expended for participation by Minority Business Enterprises and ten percent (10%) of the contract amount be expended for participation by Women Business Enterprises. It is up to the contractor to determine how they will achieve this goal for the contract amount.
