3) Questions:

- a) Is the Sports & Exhibition Authority open to an Excel and IMPLAN-based approach to calculating economic impacts? If not, is there an alternate preferred software format?
 - i) The SEA does not have a preferred software format.
- b) Would the SEA be open to a company performing in-house economic impact assessments via a custom economic impact model?
 - i) Yes
- c) What is the SEA Budget for this Project?
 - i) The SEA prefers not to provide a budget estimate for this RFP.
- d) What information/input data does the Sports Event Program collect?
 - i) Currently, we collect the following data inputs:
 - (1) Event type
 - (2) Dates (Start and end)
 - (3) Number of Participants
 - (4) Number of Spectators
 - (5) Total attendance
 - (6) Total local trips (50 Miles or Less Outside Allegheny County)
 - (7) Total day trips (50 to 100 Miles Outside Allegheny County)
 - (8) Total overnight stays (100 Miles or More Outside Allegheny County)
 - (9) Hotel room nights
- e) What reporting or outputs does the SEA want to see?
 - The main output we want to see is the direct spending the event is bringing into Allegheny County.
 - ii) It would be helpful if the economic impact assessment could also include relevant and location tax information to provide the SEA with a more holistic economic impact dollar amount, but this is not necessary.
- f) How many projects/events' economic impact calculations does the SEA anticipate needing annually?
 - i) The Sports Event Funding program has two application periods (December 15 January 15 and June 15 to July 15). Annually, combining these two periods we

receive between 30 to 40 applications. For each application, we run a pre-event economic impact assessment. If awarded a Sports Event Funding program grant, we also run a post-event economic impact assessment. Therefore, annually we require approximately 60 to 80 economic impact assessment for our grant program.

- g) Is a company able to submit a proposal if they can not meet the MBE/WBE requirements?
 - i) Yes, the MBE/WBE participation is a goal not a requirement.
