SPORTS & EXHIBITION AUTHORITY OF PITTSBURGH AND ALLEGHENY COUNTY SPORTS COMMISSION SPORTS EVENT FUNDING (SEF) PROGRAM

July 2023 Grant Award Announcement

PITTSBURGH, PA: – The Sports & Exhibition Authority of Pittsburgh and Allegheny County ("SEA") and its Sports Commission have announced that it will award a total of \$775,000 to sixteen (16) organizations through their Sports Event Funding ("SEF") Program. This program provides financial assistance to support major sporting events that provide significant economic impact to Allegheny County, with substantial hotel occupancy and tourism spending. Eligible events include athletic or Esports events, whether professional or amateur, that are regulated and sanctioned by a regional, national, or international organization or association. Funding of up to \$75,000 is available in the form of a grant or loan, and the event must occur within two years of the application date.

A veterans' hockey tournament to be held May 17, 2024 through May 19, 2024, at the Robert Morris University Island Sports Center. Grant amount - \$30,000

Two amateur youth wrestling tournaments, Battle in the Burgh to be held Saturday, September 2, 2023, and West Penn Duals to be held Saturday, November 11, 2023 through Sunday, November 12, 2023, at the Monroeville Convention and Events Center. Grant amount - \$30,000

National tryouts to be held July 11, 2024 through July 14, 2024, at various locations in Allegheny County. Grant amount - \$75,000

Marathon to be held May 3, 2024 through May 5, 2024, on the streets of Pittsburgh. Grant amount - \$50,000

10-mile race to be held November 5, 2023, on the streets of Pittsburgh. Grant amount - \$45,000

Two hockey tournaments to be held January 5, 2024 through January 7, 2024, at Alpha Ice Complex and Ice Castle Arena. Grant amount - \$60,000

Professional and amateur squash tournament to be held February 7, 2024 through February 11, 2024, at the Rivers Club. Grant amount - \$30,000

Funding for the program is provided by the Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund. The next 2023 round of SEF applications will be accepted approximately December 15, 2023 through January 15, 2024.
